In the end of 2024, we shifted focus to the Holidays. One way we spread Holiday cheer was with with decor!

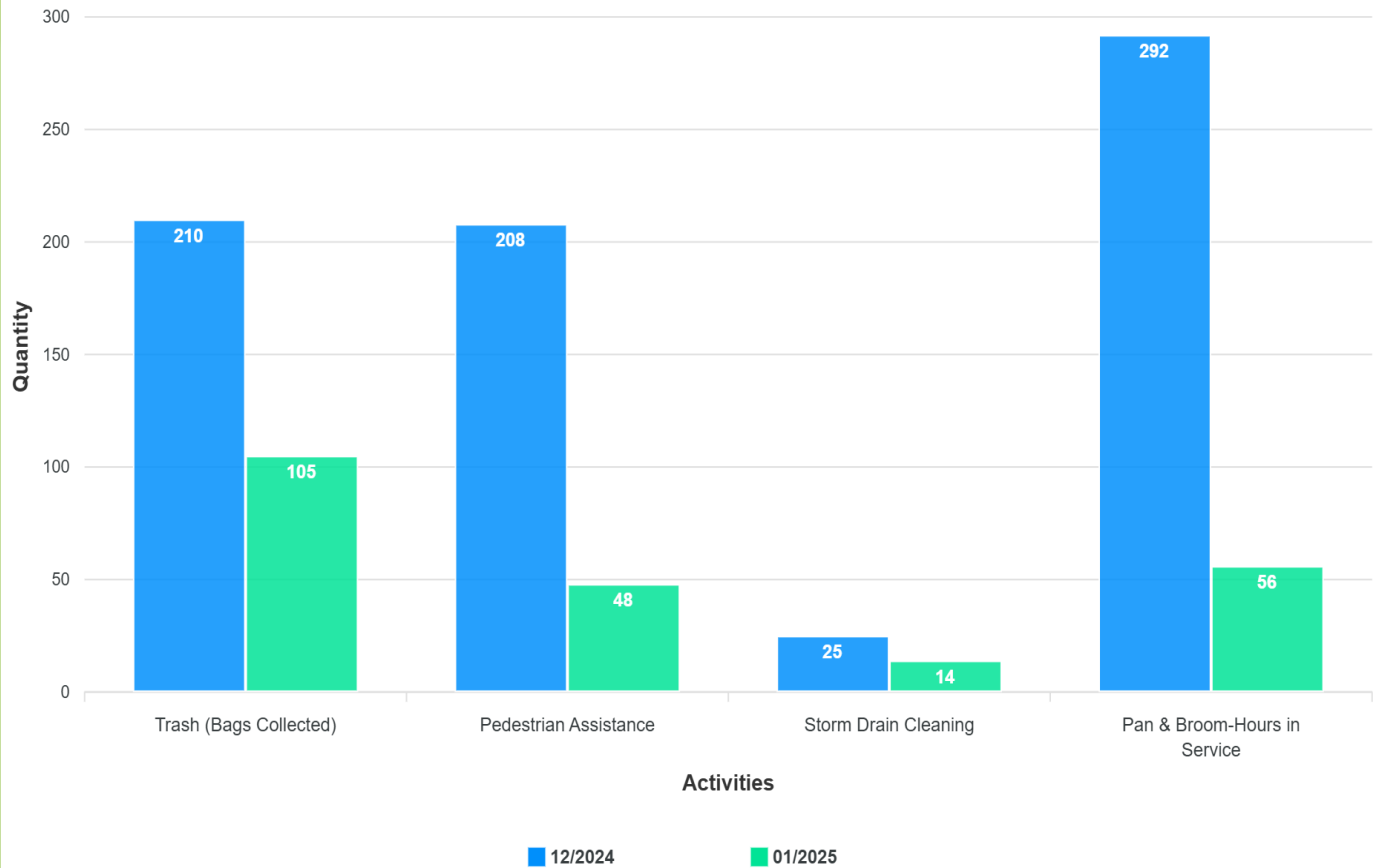


This was a great time for us at BID services to work on training and team building, while staying focused on continuing to make the BID great!



Cleaning Highlights

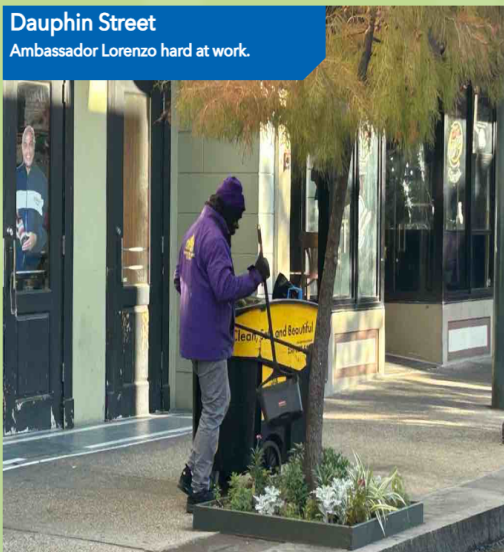
December 01 2024 to January 10 2025

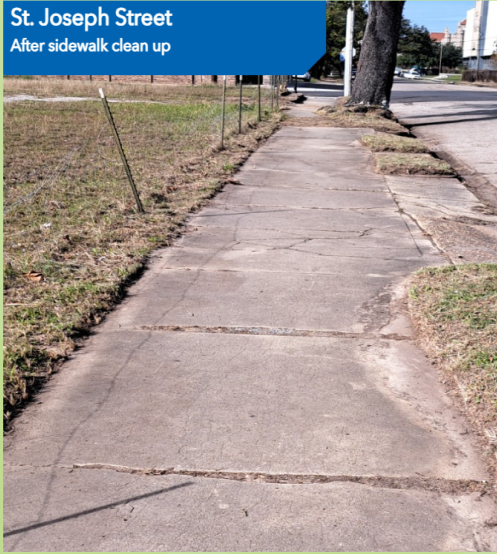
Summary

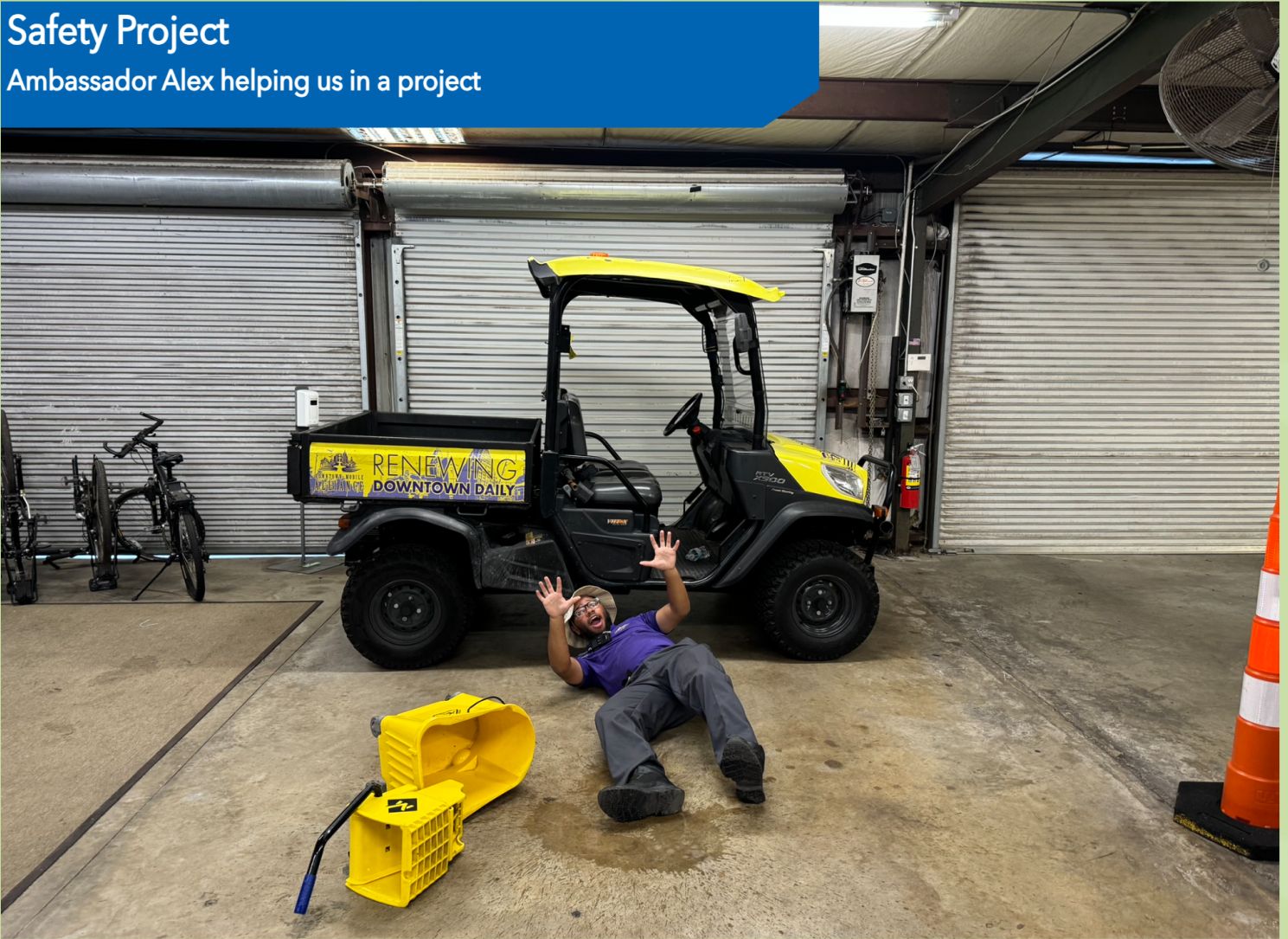

Not only is safety on our streets important, but also ambassador safety at all times is important. This was a fun way to work on safety with making a slips, trips, and falls poster.

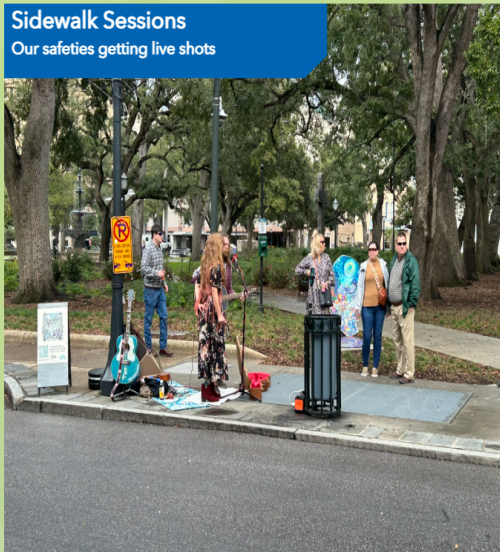
